To qualify for Deferred Disposition, you must meet the following requirements:

- Must be at least age 17 at time of offense.
- Must not have had a Commercial Driver's License at the time of the offense or have one presently.
- Violation was not in a construction zone with worker's present.
- The citation was not a result of an accident.
- You must not have illegally passed a school bus loading or unloading.



I, the undersigned defendant, do hereby waive the filing and reading of a sworn complaint, waive my right to trial (jury or non-jury), and enter my plea of no contest to the above numbered case and request that I be granted deferred disposition. I understand by entering a plea of no contest, I agree to pay the court-ordered fines, court costs, and/or fees. I do also swear, or affirm, that I meet all the qualifications listed above to request the Deferred Disposition option.

I understand that if I was under 25 years of age on the date of the offense, I must complete a Driving Safety Course. I also understand that if I have a Provisional Driver's License, I must retake the DPS Driving Exam.

This request for Deferred Disposition must be received, no later than 20 calendar days from the date your citation was issued. (Call the court @972-771-4601, ext.127 or www.cityoffate.com for amount *only*) If you decide to do this option by mail, do **not** pay online. Upon approval by the Judge, the deferral period of 90 days will begin on the date payment is received by the Court.

The defendant MUST NOT BE CONVICTED of any similar violations of the law during the deferred period.

Additionally, if a Driving Safety is required, I must return my completion certificate to the Court prior to the end of the Deferral period. Also, if a DPS Driving Exam is required, I must submit proof of the examination to the Court prior to the end of the Deferral period.

By signing below, I acknowledge the terms/requirements of the Deferred Disposition and swear or affirm that I meet the qualifications listed above.
